

Project Management Professional (PMP) Credential

What does having the PMP credential mean for an individual?

- They demonstrate a proficient level of project management leadership skills,
- Are able to command salaries that exceed those of non-credentialed Project Manager

To be eligible for a PMP credential –

- Must meet specific guidelines
- Guidelines consist of experience, education and professional knowledge
- Must pass a multiple-choice exam that assesses abilities in project management

Eligibility for the Exam

35 hours of specific project management education (eg 5 days DDLS Project management Systemation training)

AND

With a Bachelor's Degree (or the global equivalent):

Must have a minimum 3 years' professional project management experience during which 4,500 hours are spent leading and directing project tasks, up to eight years from the time of application

Without a Bachelor's Degree (or the global equivalent):

Must have a minimum 5 years' professional project management experience, during which at least 7,500 hours are spent leading and directing project tasks, up to eight years from the time of application.



The PMP Exam

4 hours long

200 multiple choice questions

Measures ability to apply knowledge, skills and techniques used in project management
