This certification is ideal for help desk personnel, service technicians, technical co-ordinators, and others who support Mac OS X customers over the phone or who perform Mac OS X troubleshooting and support in schools and businesses.

### Certification Track

ACSP: The Apple Certified Support Professional (ACSP) certification verifies an understanding of Mac OS X core functionality and an ability to configure key services, perform basic troubleshooting, and assist end users with essential Mac OS X capabilities. This certification addresses the technical skills needed by a Mac OS X specialist who works at a help desk or otherwise assists Mac OS X users with technical issues. The currently required exam is based on Mac OS X v10.5.

### Who Should Seek ACSP Certification?

The ACSP certification is intended for Mac OS X help desk specialists, technical co-ordinators, service technicians, and others who support Mac OS X customers.

Typical candidates for this certification are help desk personnel in businesses using Mac OS X systems for general productivity or creative design, service technicians who support Mac OS X customers, and technical co-ordinators or power users who manage networks of Mac OS X systems in their organisations — such as teachers and technology specialists who manage classroom networks or computer labs.

This certification is not intended for high-end system administrators or engineers, but is a good first step on an intended career path to system administration.

### Requirements

Candidates for ACSP 10.5 certification are required to pass one exam:

- Mac OS X Support Essentials v10.5 Exam (9L0-402)

Covers a practical knowledge of the core functionality of Mac OS X 10.5 and the basics of managing Mac OS X client systems running Mac OS X version 10.5. The recommended preparatory course for this exam is the [Mac OS X Support Essentials v10.5](#) course.

The Apple Certified Support Professional (ACSP) 10.5 certification is granted upon successful completion of this exam.

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**NOTE:** Due to the considerable number of changes and new features from Mac OS X v10.4 Tiger to v10.5 Leopard, there are no update exams for Tiger to Leopard certifications.

### **Registration**

Exams are administered by Prometric, a worldwide provider of comprehensive technology-based testing and assessment services, at testing centres worldwide.

Candidates are required to have an Apple Tech ID number before registering for an exam.
